- [Idaho Foodbank](#) – Boise, ID – Grant dollars will support their Backpack Program, ensuring that students who are chronically hungry have access to adequate food over the weekend by providing them with a backpack full of nutritious food every Friday during the school year.
- [Not A Runaway](#) – Capitol Heights, MD – Not A Runaway’s mission is to help in the recovery of missing teenagers that have been deemed runaways. Funds will be used to help develop a missing persons app to help disseminate information.

Brady Shines’ next cycle launched June 1<sup>st</sup> and will accept applications through August 31<sup>st</sup>. Non-profits in all Brady geographic territories focused on education- and youth-based programs are invited to submit grant proposals for consideration.
